St Martin's, Walsall is located on the corner of Sutton Road and Daffodil Road. Our address is St Martins Church, 1 Daffodil Rd, Walsall WS5 3DQ

Public transport

The closest stations are **Sutton Road, Wood End Rd** and **Daisy Bank, Wood End Road**.

Bus routes include numbers 77,77A and 935.

Driving

If you are driving to St Martin's. The church has a car park which can be accessed via Daffodil Road.

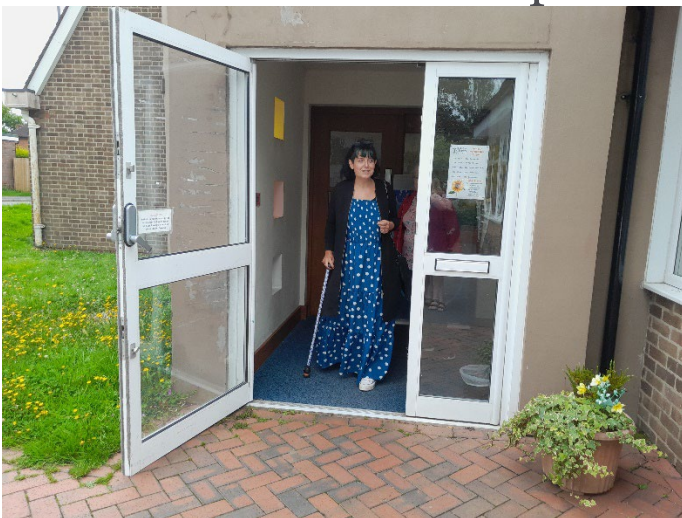
There is also on-street parking on Daffodil Road.

Arrival

St Martins can be entered using the front



or rear Door, both have step free access. The rear door is next to the car park



Accessibility

Most areas of St Martin's have step-free access. We also have a range of facilities to aid visitors with disabilities:

Toilets suitable for wheelchair users and visitors with buggies as well as baby-changing facilities are located in the rear of the building.



An induction loop is in place in church. Hearing aids should be adjusted to the T position.

Service sheets and newsletters are produced in a large font.

Guide dogs are welcome and we can supply water.

Facilities

Visitors with mobility issues

- Toilets suitable for wheelchair users and families with buggies are available and accessible. Baby changing facilities are also available.
- The chairs are movable so you can sit wherever you want to.



- There is a small step onto the Dias.



- All doors are wide.



Visitors with hearing issues

- An induction loop is available in Church for services, concerts and education events. Hearing aid users should adjust their hearing aid to the T position.

Visitors with sight issues

- Service sheets and newsletters are produced in large format.
- Guide dogs are welcome and can be supplied with water if it is required.

Visitors with Cognitive Impairment

- The building is well signposted to towards the toilets and hall and back to the church

- Baby-changing facilities can be found in the Toilets.
